

Tuition Assistance

Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School, 2009–2010

We are aware that parents/guardians have a choice to make about their child's high school education. Sending a student to Mission College Prep is a significant investment. We cannot meet all need, however we are committed to doing the best that we can. The process of applying for tuition assistance relies on good communication between the parents/guardians and the school. We ask that you communicate with us regarding your circumstances and walk through the tuition assistance process with us.

Facts:

1. 2009–2010 estimated costs including tuition, registration deposit and books -- \$10,500
2. Total tuition assistance awarded for the 2009–2010 school year -- \$132,000
3. Average award -- \$2,500
4. MCP offers awards up to 50% of the cost of tuition.
5. Award packages may include a combination of a grant and work-to-study program.

Tuition Assistance Application Process:

1. First, the student must be offered admission to Mission College Prep.
2. The filing of the registration deposit holds a space for the student.
3. Now families complete and submit the tuition assistance application offered through Private School Aid.
4. Private School Aid completes an analysis of all applications for tuition assistance and provides MCP with an assessment.
5. The MCP Tuition Assistance Committee meets and makes decisions.
6. Finally MCP notifies families of the decision.

Notes:

1. The registration deposit will be refunded if a family has applied for tuition assistance, but does not receive what is needed, and withdraws their student's application.
2. Historically, tuition increases annually by 5%.
